

# Activity 1.1.2 - Safe Password Poster

## Instructions:

### Part 1: Creating your password

1. Select a phrase that has at least 6 words in it, and note having a number in the phrase will help:

*Example:*      *three blind mice see how they run*

2. Take the first letter of each word in the phrase:

*Example:*      *tbmshtr*

3. Take any numbers and turn them into numerals:

*Example:*      *3bmshtr*

4. Make two of the letters upper case:

*Example:*      *3bMshtR*

5. If you don't have a number, add it to the beginning. If you do have a number, add a special character to the beginning.

*Example:*      *[3bMshtR*

6. Now add a colon (:) or = at the end

*Example:*      *[3bMshtR=*

7. This will be your base password. Now for every website where you register, you will add three or four identifying letters to your password.

*Example:*      *[3bMshtR=FBK*  
*[3bMshtR=AMZ*  
*[3bMshtR=TWT*  
*[3bMshtR=INST*
